Camp will focus on polishing the performing and collaborative skills of young pianists. The pianists will be assigned instrumental and vocal accompanying compositions appropriate to their level and musical experience. The music will then be sent to the applicant to prepare before the commencement of the camp. During the camp, the pianists will be partnered with an instrumentalist and a singer for coaching and practice sessions. Final Performance will be on Friday at 1 pm. Students should have intermediate to advanced piano skills with at least 3 years of private study. A CD of a recent performance must accompany the application form.

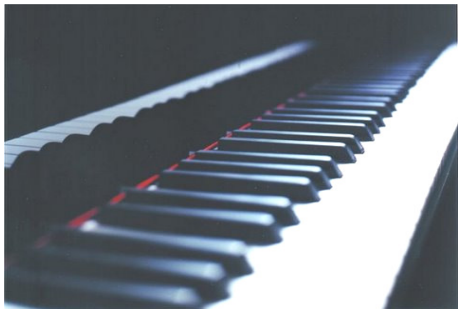
